The ITINERARY is flexible, according to your wishes before and during the cruise. The captain validates the itinerary according to security imperatives, weather and the return date.



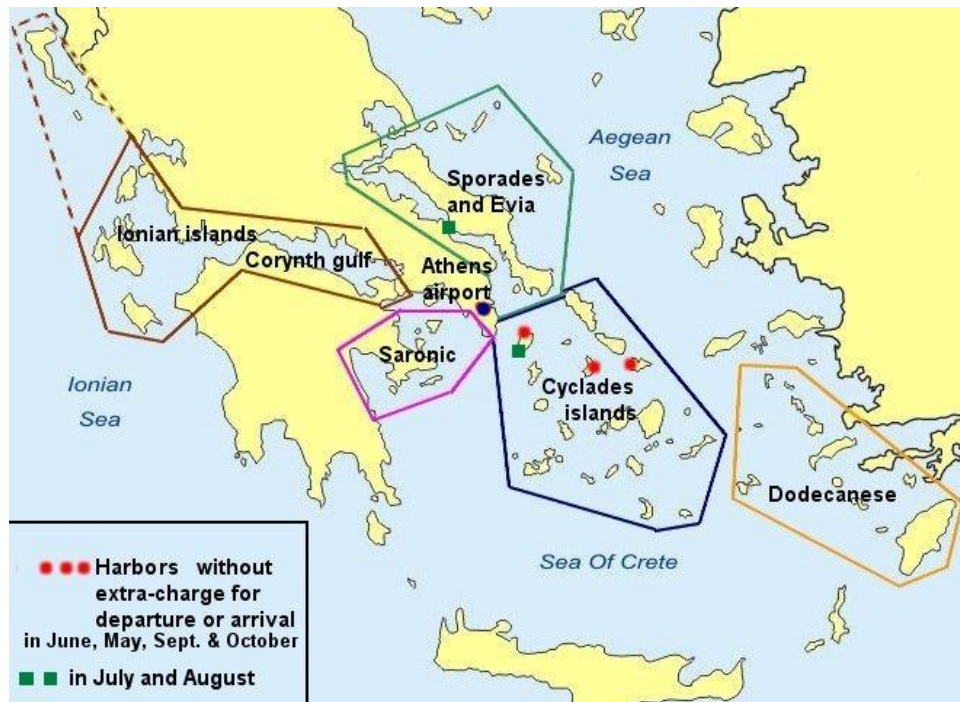

Cyclades, better in May, June, September and October

In this Archipelago, you will find islands of a wild and arid beauty, of which Mykonos is certainly very touristy, but superb...; Delos, Apollo's island, exceptional ancient site, open sky museum; Amorgos, the island of "Deep Blue" movie; Syros, astonishing capital of Cyclades; Milos, the paradise of coves; Santorini, superb point of view (but far away, very touristy and no harbour....);

Sporades islands – all year

These pines covered islands present a quite different face from arid Cyclades. In Skiathos, Skopelos, Alonissos and Skyros, one can associate the large island of Evia and spots of Pelion (Trikeri). A natural reserve is in the North Sporades, home to Europe's most endangered mammal – the Mediterranean Monk seal.

Captain advises :

If you have only one week, it will be necessary to start from Skiathos (airport) or to choose a "one way". Over 2 weeks, you will be able to do the "large tour" (Evia and Sporades) and to start from a "base port" (Lavrion/Athens or Syros), without extra-charge. Spend one night on anchorage on the small island of "Panagia", with its natural port. The winds are much less strong than in the Cyclades. Good to visit from June to August, even September. Very convenient for a quiet cruise with children.

SPECIFICATIONS :

IRINA is a 74 ton wooden sloop, registered as professional tourist sailing boat by the Greek Authorities. For this reason she is allowed to sail with winds 6 Beaufort and stronger rather other professional tourist boats up to 83 feet are not. Her equipment includes state of the art navigation equipment.

IRINA has a heavy duty 360HP turbo Volvo marine engine and around 200 square meters sails. There is a tender (dinghy) with Yamaha outboard engine, autopilot, 2 VHF, 2 GPS and the electronic standard equipment. There is also 220AC adapter to charge your telephone, camera or MP3 player.

There is also a generator for any big AC power need. Of course there is electric fridge, 2000 litre water tanks, hot water and air conditioning in all the cabins.

There is snorkelling equipment, fishing lines, and the possibility to connect your MP3 player on the yacht stereo. The bar is open for basic beverages (refreshment or beers) and you can also bring and drink your bottles without extra-charge. There is a sundeck area with sun beds.
